Students have been preparing and familiarizing themselves for SBAC using the online tools. It is also helpful that the format for SBAC is similar to the district trimester interim assessments. ## Construction Update

Since last summer, a new building on the south-west side of Repetto's campus has been under construction. This project is now rounding the bend to completion. Though there are still many details to finalize, the anticipated completion date is July 10, 2016. Sixth, seventh, and eight grade students will begin the 2016-2017 school year in their new state-of-the-art classrooms. Each of the eleven classrooms will be equipped with a ceiling-mounted LCD projector, an audio sound system compatible with different types of technology, document cameras, Wi-Fi connections, and more. Portable classrooms located on the upper and lower playgrounds will be moved off our campus, which will immensely increase the area for our students to play during recess and lunch. Students will have a grass area with a new blacktop on the upper playground/field.
