- Open House:** We hope all parents will join us at Open House on Thursday, May 8th, beginning at 6:30 p.m. All classes will be showcasing their accomplishments during the 2013-14 school year. Come early and join us for dinner. The eighth-grade promotion committee will open their concession stand at 5:30 p.m. Uniforms will also be available for purchase. Mark the date on your calendar, and be on the lookout for a flyer that will be sent home with more information.
- New Student Enrollment:** We are currently enrolling new students for the 2014-15 school year (by appointment only). Appointments can be made by calling the school office at 626-572-2231. A list of required documentation can be found at the district website: www.ausd.us.
- Permit Renewals:** If your child is currently attending Repetto on a permit and plans to apply for a renewal for the 2014-15 school year, please come to the office to pick up a new permit application. Applications are also available at the district website: www.ausd.us. (You need to complete a new application, but in most cases, do not need to obtain a release from your school/district of residence.) Approval of permit renewals will be based on satisfactory academic progress, behavior, attendance, and parent cooperation, and is also contingent on available space.
- Tdap Shots:** We want to remind all current sixth graders to make sure they get their Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) immunization as soon as possible. If possible, submit proof of this immunization by the end of the school year. Incoming seventh-grade students may not enter school in August without proof of receiving their Tdap on or after their seventh birthday.
- At-Risk Eighth Graders:** There is only one month left to raise your grades and be eligible to participate in the promotion ceremony. Work hard and do your best!

Super Bowl Cinco

Repetto students will celebrate "Cinco de Mayo on Quince de Mayo" (May 15th) at our fifth annual Roadrunner Super Bowl event. The "super bowl" refers to the giant 6-foot diameter bowl that students will once again use to create a 200-pound salad.

This year, we are making a Corn Salsa Salad, and are tying the event to a slightly-belated Cinco de Mayo celebration. (We cannot celebrate on the actual date of May 5th because the state testing window will not be completed by then.) In addition to an exciting schoolwide ceremony, all students will visit several interactive stations designed to encourage them to be physically active and to make healthy eating choices.

On May 15th, all students may come to school dressed in red, white, and green (the colors of the Mexican flag). *Please note: It is NOT a non-uniform day. Students who do not follow the theme must come dressed in their uniform. Also, breakfast will only be served BEFORE school that day. Second chance breakfast will not be served during recess.*
