ONLINE ENROLLMENT SYSTEM

The Alhambra Unified School District is excited to announce the PowerSchool online student enrollment system for the 2018-19 school year. This system is now active and can be accessed through the district website at www.ausd.us.

- **RETURNING STUDENTS:** Snapcodes will be mailed out to parents of returning students to link, verify and update their child's demographic information.
- **NEW ENROLLMENTS:** To register a new student, click on "Enrollment" at the very top of the district website. Upon completion of the online portion, parents will be prompted to call the school office at (626) 570-6240 to set up an appointment to verify the required **support documents** and finalize the new enrollment.
